

ORDER SUMMARILY
SUSPENDING REGISTRATION

Pursuant to G.S. § 150B-3(c) and 21 N.C.A.C. 46.2006(b), the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy ("Board"), vis Members Wallace E. Nelson, J. Parker Chesson, Jr., Rebecca W. Chater, Betty H. Dennis, L. Stan Haywood, and Robert (Joey) McLaughlin, Jr. finds that the protection of the public health, safety and welfare requires emergency action. Accordingly, the Board hereby Summarily Suspends Technician Registration No. 19011 issued to Elaine Stephens ("Respondent Stephens"), effective upon service of this Order. Respondent Stephens shall immediately cease any practice of pharmacy in North Carolina pending issuance by the Board of a Final Agency Decision.

A hearing before the Board regarding the charges against Respondent Stephens shall be conducted on January 15, 2008, at the Board's office located at 6015 Farrington Road, Suite 201, Chapel Hill, North Carolina. If Respondent Stephens wishes to appear before the Board at this meeting, Respondent Stephens shall notify the Board's Executive Director in writing within ten (10) days of receiving service of this Order, after which the Board will serve Respondent Stephens with a Notice of Hearing in accordance with G.S. § 150B-38(b).


