Kesha Thomas was issued Technician Registration No. 12205 by the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy on September 28, 2004, such registration being active until December 31, 2012.

Ms. Thomas admits that while working as a registered technician at Omnicare Pharmacy permit No. 10990, located at 3625 Willard Farrow Dr., she committed acts that give the Board sufficient cause to revoke her technician registration in North Carolina.

Considering that, Ms. Thomas voluntarily surrenders her registration to be a technician in a pharmacy in North Carolina. The surrender of the registration is made voluntarily and without pressure, coercion, or the threat of force being made against her. As a result of the voluntary surrender, Ms. Thomas shall not be present in any North Carolina pharmacy in any capacity other than as a customer/patient, with a valid prescription from a treating physician, unless and until the Board issues any further order.

Ms. Thomas understands and accepts that, at any point in the future, she may petition for reinstatement by submitting a request to the Board of Pharmacy, in writing. Upon a request for reinstatement, the Board will determine within sixty (60) days when it will schedule a hearing on the request for reinstatement. That hearing will be scheduled at the Board's discretion. There is no presumption, guarantee or other implication intended within this document that the Board will reinstate the registration.

The decision will be made by the Board based on consideration of all available evidence presented at a formal hearing before the Board. The license will not be returned until and unless the Board issues a reinstatement order after any formal hearing.
