THIS MATTER was heard on March 17, 2009, by the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy (the "Board") located at 6015 Farrington Road, Suite 201, Chapel Hill, North Carolina, upon the request of Rhonda Lea Tonsend (the "Petitioner") for reinstatement of her registration as a technician in the State of North Carolina. Board President Haywood and Board members Chesson, Dennis, and McLaughlin conducted this hearing. After hearing the testimony of witnesses, adjudging the credibility of the witnesses and receiving evidence, the Board makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. At all relevant times, Petitioner was registered as a technician and was the holder of registration number 11986.
- 2. Petitioner was previously employed as a pharmacy technician at Vanceboro Pharmacy. Petitioner was terminated from employment at Vanceboro Pharmacy.
- 3. Board investigator Joshua Kohler investigated the circumstances surrounding Petitioner's discharge.
- 4. Investigator Kohler determined that there was no evidence that Petitioner diverted any medications from Vanceboro Pharmacy and no evidence that Petitioner had otherwise violated the North Carolina Pharmacy Practice Act or rules promulgated by the Board.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Petitioner has demonstrated good cause for approval of reinstatement of her technician registration,. Because a technician cannot register without active employment as a technician and Petitioner does not have a current offer of employment, Petitioner's registration is not restored at this time; however, Petitioner is declared to be eligible to register at such time as she submits an application that conforms to the Pharmacy Practice Act and its regulations, if she qualifies for registration at the time of application.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Petitioner is eligible to register as a technician at such time as she submits an application that conforms to the Pharmacy Practice Act and its regulations, if she qualifies for registration at the time of that application.
