To whom it may concern,

This letter is to notify the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy of RXQ Compounding, LLC's decision to issue a voluntary recall of 1 lot of RXQ's Lidocaine 1% and Epinephrine 1:100,000 50mL Vial (MDV) product shipped between 06/22/2018 to 09/05/2018. The product is being recalled because the product may produce sub therapeutic levels of numbing when used subcutaneously or topically. This recall has been initiated due to faulty laboratory testing results provided by Eagle Analytical Services, Houston, TX. Eagle Analytical Services tested the product in question and the end product testing data provided to RXQ was inaccurate.

This recall is being conducted in an abundance of caution, as at this time, there have been no customer complaints or reports of adverse events. This recall is also being conducted with the knowledge of FDA.
