**Biosimilar and Interchangeable Products in the US: Scientific Concepts, Clinical Use,

This webinar will provide an overview of biosimilar and interchangeable products; the approval process in the United States; and the various scientific concepts used in the development of biosimilar products. FDA's approval standards will also be explained. In addition, the webinar will describe some practical information regarding use of these products, such as labeling, terminology, and pharmacy substitution, and review the resources available to health care professionals about biosimilar and interchangeable products.
