Gail Bartholomew Cox was issued license number 11510 by the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy on September 17, 1991, such license being active until December 31, 2010.


Mrs. Cox admits that while working as a licensed pharmacist with Kerr Drug Pharmacy permit No. 6880, located at 123 E. Center St. Mebane, North Carolina, she committed acts that give the Board sufficient cause to revoke her license to practice pharmacy in North Carolina.

Considering that, Mrs. Cox voluntarily surrenders his license to practice pharmacy in North Carolina. The surrender of the license is made voluntarily and without pressure, coercion, or the threat of force being made against her. As a result of the voluntary surrender, Mrs. Cox shall not be present in any North Carolina pharmacy in any capacity other than as a customer/patient, with a valid prescription from a treating physician, unless and until the Board issues any further order.

Mrs. Cox understands and accepts that, at any point in the future, she may petition for reinstatement by submitting a request to the Board of Pharmacy, in writing. Upon a request for reinstatement, the Board will determine within sixty (60) days when it will schedule a hearing on the request for reinstatement. That hearing will be scheduled at the Board's discretion. There is no presumption, guarantee or other implication intended within this document that the Board will reinstate the license.


The decision will be made by the Board based on consideration of all available evidence presented at a formal hearing before the Board. The license will not be returned until and unless the Board issues a reinstatement order after any formal hearing.
