In addition to the completion of the NC Board of Pharmacy Application, candidates should register online for the NAPLEX and MPJE Exams at www.nabp.net .

APPROVAL FOR NAPLEX & MPJE EXAMS

Candidates are approved for the NAPLEX and MPJE exams on Thursday of each week by the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy. The Board does not approve any candidate for examinations until we have received your Certificate of Graduation certifying your graduation. Once the Board of Pharmacy has approved you for the exam(s), an ATT (Authorization to Test) will be issued to you by Pearson VUE.

CHECK EXAM RESULTS ONLINE:

Candidates may check **NAPLEX and MPJE Exam** results online at www.ncbop.org under PHARMACIST LICENSURE INFORMATION. Under PHARMACIST LICENSURE INFORMATION select Licensure By Exam. Login by typing your EXAMINEE ID and PIN number. **Your EXAMINEE ID** number is printed on the front of your acknowledgement receipt and your PIN number is the last four digits of your social security number. You may also report address changes at this site. Candidates should expect grades to be posted on the Board's website 3-5 business days after taking the exam. The minimum acceptable passing score for the NAPLEX and MPJE is 75.

NOTIFICATION OF EXAM RESULTS/LICENSURE:

Candidates will be notified by letter of exam results and licensure upon successful completion of ALL exams. **Candidates will be licensed on Thursday of each week and may check for verification of licensure online at the Board's website www.ncbop.org by choosing verify a license under pharmacist's information.** Candidates may also change residence addresses at this site.
